



CAMPING CONTRACT RENTAL AGREEMENT

The individual whose name the reservation was made in must be of the Age of 18 years old and will be responsible for the campsite and the occupants.

DEPOSIT -- A reservation deposit is required to make a reservation and may be done with a Visa, Discover, or MasterCard. **We do not except personal checks.** Reservations are accepted up to one year to the day in advance of arrival. Specific sites are reserved on a first-come, first reserved basis. We try to honor all requests for specific sites, but do reserve the right to change site numbers. To avoid any misunderstandings, you will be charged for the number of nights of your reservation, so please check your dates carefully. All site damages or excessive cleaning will be charged to the credit card provided to us for the deposit by the lessee. **Sites reserved in advanced have a two-night minimum. Holidays are a three to four night minimum.**

CANCELLATION POLICY -- If site is canceled 7 days prior to your arrival date the deposit will be refunded minus a \$10.00 per site cancellation fee. If less than 7 days prior to your arrival the deposit is non-refundable. Early departures and no shows due to weather or any other reason will not receive a refund. If you do not show up for your reservation you will be charged the entire amount of the reservation. The individual whose name is on the reservation must confirm all reservation changes.

CHECK-IN -- is from 2:00 pm to Office Closing. Early arrival could result in unnecessary waiting. Late check-ins must call to make prior arrangements and pay the balance due in full with the office. Call for closing hours as these vary. There will be no check-ins after 11:00 pm. After that time you must wait until the following day when the office opens. For your convenience, you may pay the balance owed for your site by cash, Visa, MasterCard, or Discover. **Before entry to the park is permitted, the registered lessee must be present. The lessee must pay for all sites, including multi site reservations, in full with one payment form at check-in.**

CHECK-OUT -- is prior to 12:00 noon.

WRISTBANDS -- Mohican Adventures guests are required to wear a wristband throughout the duration of their stay. Please bring all guests into the office at check in to receive their wristbands. Mohican Adventures provides accommodations second-to-none in the area and the wristbands control overcrowding of facilities that guests have paid to use. Guests seen without wristbands are considered to be trespassing on private property and will be evicted from the park. Ask the office personnel at check in about all the area discounts one receives with their wristband.

OCCUPANCY -- The state of Ohio and Ashland County Health Department imposes the regulation of site occupancy. Sites hold a maximum of 4 adults and 4 children. Maximum occupancy noncompliance will result in eviction. There must be at least one person 18 and older actually staying on the site. **FULL HOOK UP SITES:** There is a maximum of 1 RV and 1 Tent allowed on all sites. Sites 101-336 must have an RV on site, No Stand Alone Tents.

PRIMITIVE TENT SITES: There is a maximum of 2 tents allowed on open field sites and 1 tent allowed on wooded sites.

VISITORS -- There is a visitor fee for guests to enter the park. The visitor fee is \$9.00 per day for anyone 11 years and older, \$5.00 per day for children 10 and under. Visitor passes must be issued to persons visiting a registered camper or cabin unit. All visitors must sign in and be out by 9:00 pm.

PETS -- are allowed on camping sites. They must be kept on a short leash and kept quiet during the night. Pets are not allowed to be left alone anytime during the night or day. Pets are strictly prohibited in all cabins and buildings. Pets may be boarded by Byland Animal Hospital by calling 419-994-5515.

QUIET TIME -- is from 11:00 pm to 7:00 am. There will be no check-ins during this time. Sounds carry farther at night. Please be considerate of others. Loud noise/music, etc. must be confined in your RV at all times. Loud or abusive language will not be tolerated. Eviction will result without any refunds.

GROUND FIRES -- Ground fires are allowed in the provided fire rings only. All fires must be attended to at all times and be out by 12:30 am. Please make sure that your fire is fully put out before leaving it unattended.

CHILDREN -- are the responsibility of the parents and must be supervised at all times. You will be held responsible for your child's safety and actions. Children under 18 must be at their site under parental supervision from dark to 7am the next day. **Children are not allowed in the pool house without adult supervision. There is no lifeguard on duty and children are the sole responsibility of their parents or guardians.**

SITE ACCOMODATIONS -- all RV and primitive tent sites include a picnic table and fire ring. RV sites are also equipped with electricity, water, and sewer. Mohican Adventures offers 30/50 amp sites, along with back-in and pull-through sites. Please request specific accommodations during reservation.

SMOKING -- is prohibited inside any buildings of Mohican Adventures according to Ohio State Law.

VEHICLES -- the maximum amount of vehicles per site varies according to site size and size of camping unit. Most RV sites and open field tent sites can hold a maximum of 2 vehicles; wooded sites hold a maximum of 1 vehicle. There is overflow parking available. All vehicles must be registered and parking permits displayed.

CLEANING -- each site must be kept free of loose materials that could cause litter. Trash must be placed in dumpsters before checkout.

CRITTERS and HAZARDS -- the Mohican Area has one of the most enjoyable ecosystems on earth, and insects are a part of that system. We try to control this natural occurrence by regularly spraying for insects. The most common pests are flies, mosquitoes, and wasps. Please let the office know if a site has a problem with wasps' nests. We do not give refunds due to any pest discomfort issue. There are also trees, water, poisonous plants, and everything in-between in our beautiful area. Camping is an outdoor experience and we are not responsible for accidents, injury, or loss of property of any kind. **Everyone must sign a participation agreement upon entering the park.**
